The Govt. College Jabera Distt. Damoh was established in 22nd July 1989 by the Deptt. of Higher Education Govt. of Madhya Pradesh. The college has been affiliated by Maharaja Chhatrasal Bundelkhand University, Chhatarpur The college at present runs four Undergraduate programmes viz., Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.), Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.) Though the college is situated in the heart of the Village, most of the students come from adjoining villages. It has a sprawling campus of about 15 acres with a built in constructed area of about 1 acres.

The college at present runs three Undergraduate programmes viz., Bachelor of Arts (BA), Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.), Bachelor of Science (B.Sc.). The present teaching strength of the college has 2 permanent Assistant professors/Professors and about 15 temporary teachers known as Guest faculties (recruited through the department of higher education on merit basis).

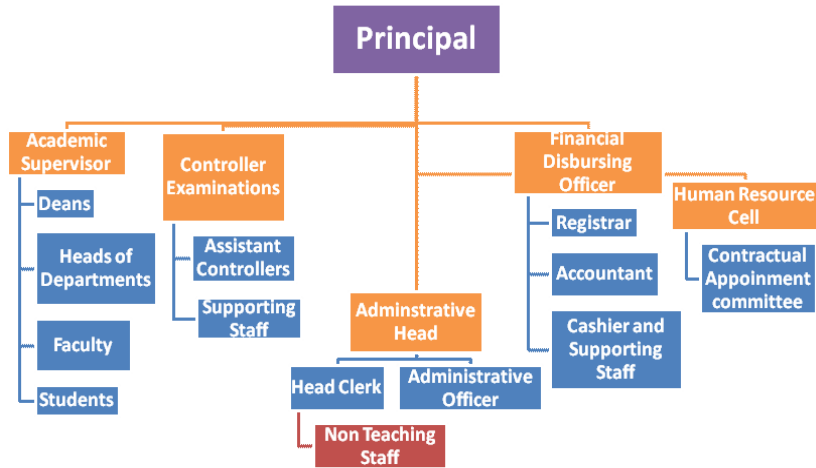
