The college has committee for ST, SC and OBC scholarship beneficiaries.

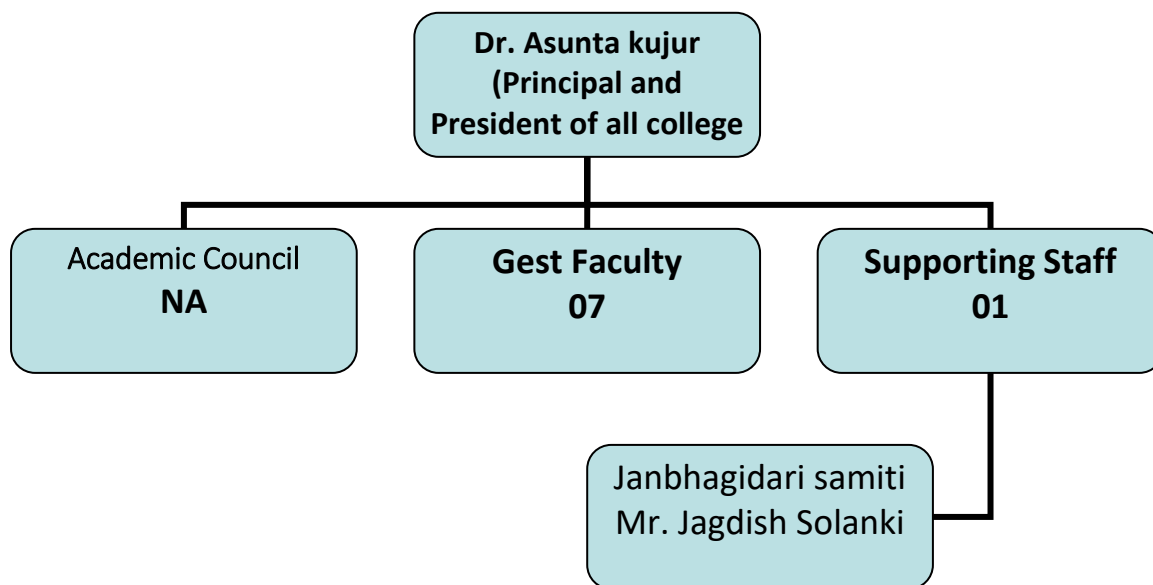
